

Garment Care and Wash Instructions

When the Boston Pizza Uniform Program was put together, durability of the fabrics was a major consideration. But, no matter how durable a fabric is, the best way to ensure a long life is to wash and care for it properly.

Front of the House Uniforms

Men's & Women's Server Shirts are machine washable in cold water. Wash with like colours and DO NOT USE BLEACH. Tumble dry on a low heat and light pressing may be required.

Women's V-Neck Stretch Server Shirts are machine washable in cold water. Wash with like colours and DO NOT USE BLEACH. Tumble dry on low heat or lay flat. Pressing is NOT REQUIRED.

3-Pocket Waiter Aprons and Hot Cloths are machine washable in cold water. Wash with like colours and DO NOT USE BLEACH. Tumble dry on low heat and light pressing will be required.

Heart of the House Uniform

Heart of the House chef jackets, for the first 2-3 washes, should be machine washed in cold water, separately, with a ½ cup of vinegar to set the dye. Wash with like colours after that and DO NOT USE BLEACH. They should be tumble dried on low heat and ironing will be required.

Kitchen Supervisor chef jackets, for the first 2-3 washes, should be machine washed in cold water, separately, with a ½ cup of vinegar to set the dye. Wash with like colours after that and DO NOT USE BLEACH. Tumble dry on low heat and ironing will be required.

Rugby and Cargo Pants are machine washable in cold water. Wash with like colours after that and DO NOT USE BLEACH. Tumble dry on low heat and ironing may be required.

4-Way Apron and Pillbox Hat are machine washable in cold water. Wash with like colors after that and DO NOT USE BLEACH. Tumble dry on low heat and ironing will *not* be required.

Delivery Driver

Delivery Jackets are machine washable in cold, tumble dry low temp to preserve the colour of the black twill.

Delivery Shirts are machine washable in cold, tumble dry low to preserve both the colour of the black fabric and the reflective quality of the piping.
